A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE LONG-TERM CARE
OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Aging, Department of Human Resources, the sum of two hundred fifty-six thousand four hundred ninety-six dollars (\$256,496) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred eighteen thousand two hundred seventy-five dollars (\$318,275) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program established by G.S. 143B-181.15 through G.S. 143B-181.25.

The funds shall be used to strengthen the State support effort and to increase the program staffing levels from 15 full-time equivalents to 25 full-time equivalents.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
