1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REVISE THE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR NONCERTIFIED PUBLIC SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO ARE CLASSIFIED AS TEACHER ASSISTANTS.

Whereas, the salaries of teacher assistants employed by public schools are significantly below those of comparable positions within the Department of Human Resources; and

Whereas, revisions have been made to the salary schedule that have resulted in disparity in the salary schedules of noncertified personnel; and

Whereas, the average salary of teacher assistants is well below the State allotment for teacher assistants; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) Effective July 1, 1993, the following salary schedule shall be applicable to noncertified public school personnel who are classified as teacher assistants:

- (b) Teacher assistants shall be placed on the new salary schedule on the basis of years of experience as a teacher or teacher assistant.
- (c) A teacher assistant who holds a current North Carolina teacher certificate shall receive an additional ten percent (10%) of base salary.
- (d) Longevity payments are not included in the revised salary schedule for teacher assistants.
- (e) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules necessary to implement the revised salary schedule for teacher assistants.
- (f) The salary schedule established by this section and the rules adopted to implement it shall apply to teacher assistants paid with local funds.
 - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
