2	AN ACT TO IMPOSE A PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ESC TAX
3	REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 96-9(a)(7) reads as rewritten:
6	"(7) Effective with the quarter ending September 30, 1992, every employer
7	with 250 or more employees, and every person or organization that, as
8	agent, reports wages on a total of 250 or more employees on behalf of
9	one or more subject employers, shall file that portion of the
10	'Employer's Quarterly Tax and Wage Report' that contains the name,
11	social security number, and gross wages of each individual in
12 13	employment on magnetic tapes or diskettes in a format prescribed by the Commission.
14	For failure of an employer to comply with this subdivision, there
15	shall be added to the amount required to be shown as tax in the reports
16	a penalty of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). For failure of an agent to
17	comply with this subdivision, the Commission shall deny the agent the
18	right to report wages and file reports for the subject employees for a
19	period of one year following the calendar quarter in which that agent

20 21 failed to comply. The Commission may reduce or waive a penalty for good cause shown."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective September 30, 1995, and applies to Employer's Quarterly Tax and Wage Reports required to be filed on or after the quarter ending September 30, 1995.
