2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR
3	NORTH CAROLINA'S DENTISTS AND DENTAL HYGIENISTS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Article 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	"§ 90-31.1. Continuing education courses required.
8	All dentists licensed under G.S. 90-30 shall be required to attend Board-approved
9	courses of study in subjects relating to dentistry. The Board shall have authority to
10	consider and approve courses, or providers of courses, to the end that those attending
11	will gain (i) information on existing and new methods and procedures used by dentists,
12	(ii) information leading to increased safety and competence in their dealings with
13	patients and staff, and (iii) information on other matters, as they develop, that are of
14	continuing importance to the practice of dentistry. The Board shall determine the
15	number of hours of study, not to exceed 5 hrs per year, within a particular period and
16	the nature of course work required. The Board may provide exemptions or waivers
17	from continuing education requirements where dentists are receiving alternate learning
18	experiences or where they have limited practices. The Board shall by regulation define
19	circumstances for exemptions or waivers for dentists who are involved in dental
20	education or training pursuits where they gain experiences equivalent to formal
21	continuing education courses, for those who have reached an advanced age and are
22	semiretired or have otherwise voluntarily restricted their practices in volume and scope,

and for such other situations as the Board in its discretion may determine meet the 1 2 purposes of this section." 3 Sec. 2. G.S. 90-34 reads as rewritten: "§ 90-34. Refusal to grant renewal of license. 4 5 For nonpayment of fee or fees required by this Article, for failure to comply with 6 continuing education requirements adopted by the Board under the authority of G.S. 90-7 31.1, or for violation of any of the terms or provisions of G.S. 90-41, G.S. 90-41 8 concerning disciplinary actions, the North Carolina State Board of Dental Examiners 9 may refuse to issue a certificate for renewal of license. As used herein in this section, the 10 term 'license' shall include includes license, provisional license or intern permit." 11 Sec. 3. Article 16 of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by 12 adding the following new section to read: 13 "§ 90-225.1. Continuing education courses required. 14 All dental hygienists licensed under G.S. 90-225 shall be required to attend Board-15 approved courses of study in subjects relating to dental hygiene. The Board shall have authority to consider and approve courses, or providers of courses, to the end that those 16 17 attending will gain (i) information on existing and new methods and procedures 18 used by dental hygienists, (ii) information leading to increased safety and competence in their dealings with patients and supervising dentists, and (iii) information on other 19 20 matters, as they develop, that are of continuing importance to the practice of dental 21 hygiene as a part of the practice of dentistry. The Board shall determine the number of hours of study, not to exceed 5 hours per year, within a particular period and the nature 22 23 of course work required. Failure to comply with continuing education requirements 24 adopted under the authority of this section shall be grounds for the Board to decline to issue a renewal certificate under G.S. 90-227." 25 26 This act becomes effective October 1, 1993, and applies to Sec. 4. 27 requirements imposed on or after that date.
