BILL SUMMARY: Adds G.S. 14-401.15 making the unauthorized duplication of a key to a state owned building a misdemeanor. Directs the Secretary of Administration to designate those persons who may duplicate such keys. Violations punishable by a fine of \$10,000, imprisonment up to 6 months, or both.

EFFECTIVE DATE: December 1, 1993; applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
