- AN ACT TO DIRECT THE JUVENILE LAW STUDY COMMISSION TO STUDY
  THE NEED TO PREVENT A MINOR UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE
  FROM FREQUENTING CERTAIN BUSINESSES UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY
- 5 A PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR CUSTODIAN.
- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. In addition to the powers and functions set forth in Article 58 of 7 Chapter 7A of the General Statutes, the Juvenile Law Study Commission shall study the 8 need to prevent a minor under 18 years of age unaccompanied by his or her parent, 9 guardian, or custodian from entering or remaining in barrooms or lounges in which 10 beer, wine, or alcoholic beverages are sold for on-premises consumption, or in billiard 11 rooms. The Commission shall determine whether owners and managers of such 12 establishments should be subject to criminal sanctions for allowing a minor 13 unaccompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or custodian to enter or remain on the 14 premises. The Commission shall report its findings to the 1995 General Assembly. 15
