A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW A DISTRICT COURT JUDGESHIP TO BE ACTIVATED IN
DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 10, BECAUSE APPROVAL UNDER SECTION 5
OF THE VOTING RIGHTS ACT IS NOT REQUIRED IN THAT DISTRICT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 200.6(c) of Chapter 321 of the 1993 Session Laws reads
as rewritten:

"(c) Subsections (a) and (b) of this section become effective November 1, 1993, or
fifteen days after the date upon which those subsections are approved under Section 5 of
the Voting Rights Act of 1965, whichever is ~~later~~ later, except that as to the additional
district court judge in District Court District 10 authorized by subsections (a) and (b) of
this section, those subsections become effective March 1, 1994."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
