AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ASSIST IN ESTABLISHING AND SUPPORTING AN ASSISTANT COUNTY FOREST RANGER IN WILKES COUNTY.

- Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Forest Resources, Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of fifteen thousand five hundred twelve dollars (\$15,512) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to assist in establishing and supporting a permanent position of Assistant County Ranger in Wilkes County; provided Wilkes County provides matching funds on the basis of sixty percent (60%) State funds to forty percent (40%) County funds.
- (b) The position established in subsection (a) of this section shall be reallocated up from temporary smokechaser to permanent Assistant County Ranger.
 - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
