1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO REMOVE CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM THE
3	CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SPRUCE PINE.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. The following described property is removed from the corporate
6	limits of the Town of Spruce Pine:
7	Being an area surrounded on the east, south and west by the North Toe River
8	and on the south by the present corporate limits and being described as follows:
9	BEGINNING on a point on the eastern bank of the North Toe River, said point being the
10	point where the present southern boundary of the Town of Spruce Pine intersects the
11	North Toe River, said point being the first point where the North Toe River enters the
12	present corporate limits of the Town of Spruce Pine and runs thence down and with the
13	bank of North Toe River on a curve bearing to the left to the point where the river again
14	crosses the southern boundary line of the present corporate limit of the Town of Spruce
15	Pine; thence running with the present southern boundary of the corporate limit of the
16	Town of Spruce Pine due west to the point of BEGINNING.
17	Sec. 2. This act shall have no effect upon the validity of any liens of the Town
18	of Spruce Pine for ad valorem taxes for years before 1996.
19	Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
