AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF STATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA RESOURCE CENTER.

8 9 Section 1. Funds appropriated to the Judicial Department for the 1995-97 biennium may not be used to provide funding to the North Carolina Resource Center, which provides representation for defendants and training and reference materials for attorneys representing defendants in postconviction proceedings in capital cases.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
