11	Pender, Richmond, Rowan, Sampson, Stanly, and Watauga Counties."

 property to the same extent as if the property were not financed under this section."
- 3 Sec. 3. Section 2 of this act applies only to Edgecombe, Greene, Jackson, and 4 Madison Counties.
- 5 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
