2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR LOW-WEALTH SCHOOL SYSTEMS
3	SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local
6	School Administrative Units the sum of sixty-five million dollars (\$65,000,000) for the
7	1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of sixty-five million dollars (\$65,000,000) for the 1996-
8	97 fiscal year for low-wealth school systems' supplemental funding.
9	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
