2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASED PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO DIM
3	BEAMS OF HEADLIGHTS AND AUXILIARY DRIVING LAMPS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 20-181 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 20-181. Penalty for failure to dim, etc., beams of headlamps.
7	Any person operating a motor vehicle on the highways of this State, who shall fail to
8	shift, depress, deflect, tilt or dim the beams of the headlamps headlamps, spot lamps, or
9	auxiliary driving lamps thereon on that person's vehicle whenever another vehicle is met
10	on such highways or when following another vehicle at a distance of less than 200 feet,
11	except when engaged in the act of overtaking and passing may, upon a determination of
12	responsibility for the offense, be required to pay a penalty of not more than ten dollars
13	(\$10.00). is responsible for an infraction and may be ordered to pay a penalty of not more
14	than one hundred dollars (\$100.00)."
15	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995.
