A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO TRANSFER TO THE CHARLOTTE DEPARTMENT OF
2 TRANSPORTATION THE AUTHORITY TO APPROVE CHANGES TO STREET
3 NAMES WITHIN THAT CITY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Section 6.209 of the Charter of the City of Charlotte, being Chapter
6 713 of the Session Laws of 1965, as added by Chapter 449 of the Session Laws of 1979,
7 reads as rewritten:

8 "Section 6.209. The ~~Charlotte-Mecklenburg Planning Commission~~ Charlotte
9 Department of Transportation may hear and approve requests to change or modify street
10 names within the City of Charlotte. Any person dissatisfied with a decision of the
11 ~~Planning Commission~~ Department may appeal to the City Council. In the event of an
12 appeal, the City Council may affirm, modify, or overturn the decision of the ~~Planning~~
13 ~~Commission~~ Department. The decision of the City Council on appeal shall be final."

14 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
