A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING,
2 WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN
3 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT
4 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE
5 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA HOSPITALS AT CHAPEL HILL AND TO
6 AMEND CHAPTER 451 OF THE 1993 SESSION LAWS REGARDING A
7 WHOLLY SELF-LIQUIDATING PROJECT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH
8 CAROLINA AT GREENSBORO.

10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11 Section 1. (a) The purpose of this section is to authorize the construction by certain
12 constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the University of North
13 Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, of the capital improvements projects listed in the act
14 for the respective institutions, and authorize the financing of these projects with funds
15 available to the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, including patient receipts at the
16 University of North Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, self-liquidating indebtedness, or
17 other funds, or any combination of these funds, but not including funds appropriated from
18 the General Fund of the State.

19 (b) The capital improvements projects authorized by this section to be constructed
20 and financed as provided in subsection (a) of this section are as follows:

40 (c) At the request of The University of North Carolina Board of Governors and
41 upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so, the Director of the
42 Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the scope of or a change in the method
43 of funding the project authorized by this section. In making a determination of whether

1 to authorize a change in scope or funding, the Director of the Budget may consult with
2 the Advisory Budget Commission. In no event may appropriations from the General
3 Fund be used for a project authorized by this section.

4 Sec. 2. (a) The purpose of this section is to amend Section 2 of the 1993
5 Session Laws, Chapter 451, as it relates to the University of North Carolina at
6 Greensboro by increasing the amount authorized for the McIver Street Parking Deck
7 from five million seven hundred eight thousand six hundred dollars (\$5,708,600) to eight
8 million forty-one thousand four hundred dollars (\$8,041,400).

9 (b) Section 2 of Chapter 451 of the 1993 Session Laws under the institutional
10 subheading "6. The University of North Carolina at Greensboro" as indicated, and
11 affecting only the project listed in this act is amended to read as follows:

12 "c. McIver Street
13 Parking Deck
14 \$8,041,400".

15 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
