A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY THE DESIRABILITY AND THE FEASIBILITY OF MERGING THE DIVISION OF TRAVEL AND TOURISM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND THE DIVISION OF PARKS AND RECREATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study the desirability and the feasibility of merging the Division of Travel and Tourism of the Department of Commerce with the Division of Parks and Recreation of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources.

Sec. 2. The study committee may submit an interim report to the 1996 Regular Session of the 1995 General Assembly. The study committee shall submit a final report of its recommendations and legislative proposals to the 1997 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
