4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 15A-1343.1 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 15A-1343.1. Criteria for selection and sentencing to IMPACT.
7	The criteria for selecting and sentencing youthful offenders to the Intensive
8	Motivational Program of Alternative Correctional Treatment as provided under G.S.
9	15A-1343(b1)(2A) shall be as follows:
10	(1) The offender must be between the ages of 16 and 25; and 35;
11	(2) The offender must be convicted of a Class 1 misdemeanor or a felony.
12	(3) The offender must submit to a medical evaluation by a physician
13	approved by his probation or parole officer and must be certified by the
14	physician to be medically fit for program participation.
15	(4) The offender must not previously have served an active sentence in
16	excess of 120 days for an offense not subject to Article 81B of this
17	chapter or of 30 days for an offense subject to Article 81B of this
18	Chapter."
19	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
