A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO ALLOW ABSENTEE VOTING CONDUCTED BY THE BLOWING
ROCK MUNICIPAL BOARD OF ELECTIONS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Charter of the Town of Blowing Rock, being Chapter 199 of the Private Laws of 1899, is amended by adding the following new section:

"Section 4.4. Absentee Voting. Absentee voting shall be allowed in the Town of Blowing Rock if city elections are conducted by a municipal board of elections, and any references in G.S. 163-302 that refer to the county board of elections shall, for the Town of Blowing Rock, refer to the municipal board of elections if city elections are conducted by a municipal board of elections. The State Board of Elections may adopt rules to regulate this section."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective with respect to all elections held on or after August 1, 1995.
