A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HEAD START PARENT-CHILD
DEVELOPMENT CENTERS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Child Development, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for the establishment of five new Head Start Parent-child Development Centers throughout the State.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Child Development, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to provide an additional twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) per year for each of the existing Head Start Parent-child Development Centers and for each of the five new centers established in accordance with Section 1 of this act.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
