3	COUNTIES, TO MAKE PROVISIONS RELATIVE TO THE STATE AND
4	FEDERAL FUNDING STREAMS FOR CONSOLIDATED HUMAN SERVICES
5	FUNCTIONS, TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEMBERSHIP OF A CONSOLIDATED
6	HUMAN SERVICES BOARD SHALL BE APPOINTED SOLELY BY THE
7	BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND TO CHANGE THE STATUS OF
8	COUNTY EMPLOYEES OF A CONSOLIDATED COUNTY HUMAN SERVICES
9	AGENCY WITH REGARD TO THEIR COVERAGE UNDER THE STATE

28	removed from office by the county board of commissioners for (i) commission of a
29	felony or other crime involving moral turpitude; (ii) violation of a State law governing
30	conflict of interest; (iii) violation of a written policy adopted by the county board of
31	commissioners; (iv) habitual failure to attend meetings; (v) conduct that tends to bring the
32	office into disrepute; or (vi) failure to maintain qualifications for appointment required
33	under this subsection. A board member may be removed only after the member has been
34	given written notice of the basis for removal and has had the opportunity to respond.
35	A member may receive a per diem in an amount established by the county board of
36	commissioners. Reimbursement for subsistence and travel shall be in accordance with a
37	policy set by the county board of commissioners. The board shall meet at least quarterly.
38	The chairperson or three of the members may call a special meeting.
