7	"(e) Scope This section applies to Ashe, Avery, Bladen, Brunswick, Cabarrus,
8	Carteret, Chowan, Columbus, Duplin, Forsyth, Franklin, Harnett, Haywood, Iredell,
9	Johnston, Lee, Macon, Nash, Orange, Pasquotank, Pender, Richmond, Rowan, Sampson,
10	Stanly, <u>Wake</u> , and Watauga Counties."
11	Sec. 2. G.S. 153A-158.1(b), as amended by Chapter 17 of the 1995 Session
12	Laws, reads as rewritten:
13	"(b) Construction or Improvement by County. – A county may construct, equip,
14	expand, improve, renovate, or otherwise make available property for use by a school
15	administrative unit within the county. The local board of education shall be involved in
16	the design, construction, equipping, expansion, improvement, or renovation of the
17	property to the same extent as if the property were not financed under this section."
18	Sec. 3. Section 2 of this act applies only to Wake County.
19	Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
