The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 135-38(a) reads as rewritten: The Committee on Employee Hospital and Medical Benefits shall consist of 12 "(a) members as follows: (1) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate; Senate or a designee thereof; The Majority Leader of the Senate; (2) The Chairman of the Senate Committee on Appropriations; (3) A Cochairman of the Senate Committee on Finance designated by the $(5)_{-}$ President Pro Tempore of the Senate; Two other members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro $(6)_{-}$ Tempore of the Senate; and Six members of the House appointed by the Speaker." Sec. 2. G.S. 135-38(a) as rewritten by Section 1 of this act reads as rewritten: The Committee on Employee Hospital and Medical Benefits shall consist of 12 members as follows: (1) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate or a designee thereof;
