Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to implement the University's school technology initiative. Of these funds, the sum of two million fifty thousand dollars (\$2,050,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year shall be used for one-time expenses.

The purpose of the program is to ensure that educators and potential educators are proficient in the use of computers for their professional needs and in the effective use of technology in their classrooms.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
