BILL SUMMARY: An act to validate certain actions of water and sewer districts and to provide for payment of relocation costs of water and sewer lines belonging to certain municipalities.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: Section 1.1 of the bill requires the Department of Transportation to relocate water and sewer line for systems organized under Chapter 162A of the General Statutes, then sold or transferred to a municipality with a population greater than 5,500. the Department of Transportation now pays the non-betterment costs of relocating lines for approximately 45 water and sewer districts organized under Chapter 162A. The bill would require no additional expenditures by the Department of Transportation.
