8	<u>(a)</u> For t	he purpose of this section, the term 'antique airplane' means an airplane
9	that meets all of the following conditions:	
10	<u>(1)</u>	It is registered with the Federal Aviation Administration and is a model
11		<u>year 1954 or older.</u>
12	<u>(2)</u>	It is maintained primarily for use in exhibitions, club activities, air
13		shows, and other public interest functions.
14	<u>(3)</u>	It is used only occasionally for other purposes.
15	<u>(4)</u>	It is owned by an individual.
16	<u>(5)</u>	It is used by the owner for a purpose other than the production of
17		income and is not used in connection with a business.
18	<u>(b)</u> <u>Antio</u>	que airplanes are designated a special class of property under Article V,
19	<u>Sec. 2(2) of t</u>	he North Carolina Constitution and shall be assessed for taxation in

- 1 accordance with this section. An antique airplane shall be assessed at the lower of its true
- 2 <u>value or five thousand dollars (\$5,000</u>)."
- 3 Section 2. This act is effective for taxes imposed for taxable years beginning 4 on or after July 1, 1998.
