A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE PAYMENT OF DELINQUENT TAXES FOR THE TOWN OF 3 BANNER ELK BEFORE RECORDING DEEDS CONVEYING PROPERTY 4 SUBJECT TO THE DELINQUENT TAXES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 305 of the Session Laws of 1963, as rewritten 6 by Section 7 of S.L. 1997-410, reads as rewritten: 7 "Section 1. The Register of Deeds of Avery County shall not receive for recordation 8 9 any deed unless the following conditions are met: 10 The deed is accompanied by a certificate from the Avery County Tax (1) Collector to the effect that all delinquent county taxes and all delinquent 11 taxes for municipalities for which the county collects taxes have been 12 13 paid with respect to the property described in the deed. 14 (2) If the property described in the deed is located in whole or in part in the Town of Newland, the deed is accompanied by a certificate from the tax 15 collector for the town to the effect that all delinquent municipal taxes 16 17 have been paid with respect to the property. If the property described in the deed is located in whole or in part in the 18 (3) Town of Banner Elk, the deed is accompanied by a certificate from the 19

1	tax collector for the town to the effect that all delinquent municipal
2	taxes have been paid with respect to the property."
3	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
