**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE  
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE TO DIRECT THE  
BOARD OF PHARMACY TO REFUND FEES ERRONEOUSLY COLLECTED.**

Whereas, the Board of Pharmacy charged persons it deemed to be "pharmacy technicians" a registration fee based on an erroneous interpretation of Chapter 231 of the 1997 Session Laws; and

Whereas, the Board of Pharmacy defined the term "pharmacy technician" without proper statutory authority; Now, therefore,  
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Board of Pharmacy shall develop a plan, including a timetable, for the repayment of fees erroneously collected.

Section 2. The Board of Pharmacy shall submit the plan in writing to the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee no later than September 1, 1998.

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
