- 1 2 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF NAGS HEAD TO ADOPT ORDINANCES 3 REQUIRING SPRINKLER SYSTEMS IN CERTAIN BUILDINGS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the North Carolina State Building Code or any general or local law to the contrary, including Chapter 143 of the General 6 Statutes, the Nags Head Board of Commissioners may require, by ordinance, the 7 installation of sprinkler systems in the following buildings that are constructed within the 8 corporate limits of the town or within the town's extraterritorial planning jurisdiction: (i) 9 buildings that are greater than 50 feet in height, (ii) nonresidential buildings that contain 10 at least 5,000 square feet of floor surface area, (iii) buildings that are designed for 11 assembly occupancy, as defined in the North Carolina Building Code, that accommodate 12 more than 50 people, and (iv) multifamily buildings that have three or more dwelling 13 units. The installation of sprinkler systems shall be completed within a reasonable period 14 of time, which shall be provided in any ordinances adopted by the Board. 15 Anv ordinances adopted pursuant to this act shall apply to existing buildings to the extent and 16 under the circumstances that the provisions of the North Carolina State Building Code 17 apply to preexisting buildings. 18 19
 - Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
