A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A NEW ASSISTANT COUNTY FOREST

- 3 RANGER POSITION IN RANDOLPH COUNTY.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Forest Resources, the sum of 7 forty thousand nine hundred twenty-eight dollars (\$40,928) for the 1997-98 fiscal year 8 and the sum of forty thousand nine hundred twenty-eight dollars (\$40,928) for the 1998-9 99 fiscal year to establish and support a new Randolph County assistant county ranger 10 position, including the purchase of equipment and operating costs associated with the 11 new position.

Section 2. Pursuant to G.S. 113-54, Randolph County shall contribute as its county share the sum of twenty-seven thousand two hundred eighty-five dollars (\$27,285) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-seven thousand two hundred eighty-five dollars (\$27,285) for the 1998-99 fiscal year.

16 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
