**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT A NATIONAL MEMORIAL  
HONORING ALL WOMEN MILITARY PERSONNEL.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Women In Military Service For America Memorial Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to support the Women In Military Service Memorial, a national memorial honoring the more than 1.8 million women who have served, or are serving, in the United States' armed services. The memorial will be located at the entrance of the Arlington National Cemetery in Washington, D. C.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
