| 4  | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:   |
| 5  | Section 1. It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird with       |
| 6  | a firearm on, from, or across the right-of-way of any public road or highway in Columbus |
| 7  | County without first obtaining the written permission of the owner or lessee of the land |
| 8  | abutting the road or the land across which the weapon is being discharged.               |
| 9  | Section 2. Section 1 of this act does not apply to the owner or lessee of the real       |
| 10 | property. A hunter recovering dogs shall not be in violation of Section 1 of this act so |
| 11 | long as all of the hunter's weapons remain in a motor vehicle.                           |
| 12 | Section 3. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.                               |
| 13 | Section 4. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife           |
| 14 | Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with  |
| 15 | general subject matter jurisdiction.   |
| 16 | Section 5. This act applies only to Columbus County.                                     |
| 17 | Section 6. This act becomes effective October 1, 1997.                                   |
