March 31, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REPEAL THE EXISTING BEAR HUNTING SEASON IN CAMDEN AND PASOUOTANK COUNTIES AND TO ESTABLISH A NEW BEAR HUNTING SEASON IN CAMDEN, CHOWAN, CURRITUCK, GATES, PASQUOTANK, AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 220 of the 1993 Session Laws is repealed. Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the season for hunting black bear opens on the first Tuesday of the eastern gun season for deer and is open each Tuesday during that season. Section 3. Section 1 of this act applies only to Camden and Pasquotank Counties. The remainder of this act applies only to Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Gates, Pasquotank, and Washington Counties. Section 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
