4	WHEREABOUTS ARE KNOWN AND THEY REFUSE TO ACCEPT SERVICE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 160A-445(b) reads as rewritten:
7	"(b) (1) Complaints or orders issued by a public officer pursuant to an
8	ordinance adopted under this Part shall be served upon persons either
9	personally or by registered or certified mail. If the identities of any
10	owners or the whereabouts of persons are unknown and cannot be
11	ascertained by the public officer in the exercise of reasonable
12	diligence, or, if the owners are known but have refused to accept
13	service by registered or certified mail, and the public officer makes an
14	affidavit to that effect, then the serving of the complaint or order upon
15	the owners or other persons may be made by publication in a
16	newspaper having general circulation in the city at least once no later
17	than the time at which personal service would be required under the
18	provisions of this Part. When service is made by publication, a notice
19	of the pending proceedings shall be posted in a conspicuous place on
20	the premises thereby affected.
