A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE EDGECOMBE COUNTY TO LEVY A COUNTYWIDE
SUPPLEMENTAL SCHOOL TAX.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. The board of commissioners of a county may levy a special tax within the county to supplement the funds from State and county allotments and thereby 6 operate schools of a higher standard by supplementing any local current expense item of 7 expenditure in the school budget. This supplemental school tax may be levied without 8 approval of the voters of the county. The proceeds of the supplemental school tax may 9 be used only to supplement the local current expense funds of the school administrative 10 units in the taxing county. If there is more than one local school administrative unit in 11 the county, the funds must be apportioned according to the membership of each unit as 12 provided in G.S. 115C-430. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the 13 supplemental school tax authorized by this section is governed by the provisions of 14 15 Article 36 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes.

- 16 Section 2. This act applies only to Edgecombe County.
- 17 Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
