1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE TOWN OF SNEADS FERRY, SUBJECT TO A REFERENDUM, AND CONCERNING ZONING BY THE TOWN OF PELETIER. 3 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. A Charter for the Town of Sneads Ferry is enacted to read: "CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF SNEADS FERRY. 6 7 "CHAPTER I. 8 "INCORPORATION AND CORPORATE POWERS.

"Section 1.1. **Incorporation and corporate powers.** The inhabitants of the Town of Sneads Ferry are a body corporate and politic under the name 'Town of Sneads Ferry'. Under that name they have all the powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities conferred and imposed upon cities by the general law of North Carolina.

"CHAPTER II.

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"CORPORATE BOUNDARIES.

"Section 2.1. **Town Boundaries.** Until modified in accordance with law, the boundaries of the Town of Sneads Ferry are as follows:

Together, along and with the above described tract are the private, dirt 20' ingress and egress easements known as Oak Lane and Fanny's Creek Lane as shown on Map Book 32, Page 222 of the Onslow County Registry.

Also excepting the incorporated areas of the Town of Chadwick Acres, as described in Chapter 1014, Session Laws of 1961.

"CHAPTER III. "GOVERNING BODY.

"Section 3.1. **Structure of governing body; number of members.** The governing body of the Town of Sneads Ferry is the Town Council, which has six members.

"Section 3.2. **Manner of electing board.** The qualified voters of the entire Town elect the members of the Council.

"Section 3.3. **Term of office of Council members.** In 1997, the three persons receiving the highest numbers of votes are elected to four-year terms, and the three persons receiving the next highest numbers of votes are elected to two-year terms. In 1999 and biennially thereafter, three members are elected for four-year terms.

"Section 3.4. **Selection of Mayor; term of office.** The qualified voters of the entire Town elect the Mayor. A mayor shall be elected in 1997 and biennially thereafter for a two-year term. The Mayor may vote on all issues before the Council.

"Section 3.5. Neither the Mayor nor the members of the Town Council shall receive any salary from the town.

"CHAPTER IV.
"ELECTIONS.

"Section 4.1. **Conduct of Town elections.** The Town Council shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis and the results determined by the plurality method as provided by G.S. 163-292.

"CHAPTER V.
"ADMINISTRATION.

"Section 5.1. **Mayor-Council plan.** The Town of Sneads Ferry operates under the Mayor-Council plan as provided by Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes."

Section 2. (a) The Onslow County Board of Elections shall establish a special candidate filing period for the 1997 municipal election.

(b) G.S. 160A-63 shall not apply to the Town until after the organizational meeting following the 1997 municipal election.

Section 3. From and after July 1, 1997, the citizens and property in the Town of Sneads Ferry shall be subject to municipal taxes levied for the year beginning July 1, 1997, and for that purpose the Town shall obtain from Onslow County a record of property in the area herein incorporated which was listed for taxes as of January 1, 1997, and the businesses in the Town shall be liable for privilege license tax from the effective date of the privilege license tax ordinance. The Town may adopt a budget ordinance for fiscal year 1997-98 without following the timetable in the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act. For fiscal year 1997-98, ad valorem taxes may be paid at par or face amount within 90 days of adoption of the budget ordinance, and thereafter in accordance

with the schedule in G.S. 105-360 as if taxes had been due and payable on September 1,
 1997.
 Section 4. (a) The Onslow County Board of Elections shall conduct an

Section 4. (a) The Onslow County Board of Elections shall conduct an election on a date set by it, to be not less than 60 nor more than 120 days after the date this act becomes law, for the purpose of submission to the qualified voters of the area described in Section 2.1 of the Charter of Sneads Ferry, the question of whether or not such area shall be incorporated as Sneads Ferry. Registration for the election shall be conducted in accordance with G.S. 163-288.2.

(b) In the election, the question on the ballot shall be:

"[] FOR [] AGAINST

Incorporation of Sneads Ferry."

 Section 5. (a) In such election, if a majority of the votes cast are not cast "FOR Incorporation of Sneads Ferry", then Sections 1 through 3 of this act shall have no force and effect.

- (b) In such election, if a majority of the votes cast shall be cast "FOR Incorporation of Sneads Ferry"then Sections 1 through 3 of this act shall become effective on the date that the Onslow County Board of Elections determines the result of the election.
 - Section 6. (a) G.S. 160A-360(f) reads as rewritten:
- "(f) When a city annexes, or a new city is incorporated in, or a city extends its jurisdiction to include, an area that is currently being regulated by the county, the county regulations and powers of enforcement shall remain in effect until (i) the city has adopted such regulations, or (ii) a period of 60 days nine months has elapsed following the annexation, extension or incorporation, whichever is sooner. During this period the city may hold hearings and take any other measures that may be required in order to adopt its regulations for the area."
- (b) This section applies to the Town of Peletier only, and is effective from and after November 4, 1996.
 - Section 7. This act is effective when it becomes law.
