2	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF FUNDS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
3	CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY FOR ANNUAL BONUSES FOR
4	ENLISTED MEMBERS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA NATIONAL GUARD WHO
5	HAVE COMPLETED THEIR INITIAL SIX-YEAR TERM OF SERVICE.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. Chapter 127A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
8	section to read:
9	" <u>§ 127A-111. Lengthy service bonuses.</u>
10	From funds annually appropriated, the Department of Crime Control and Public
11	Safety shall provide an annual lengthy service bonus of one hundred fifty dollars
12	(\$150.00) per year to members of the North Carolina National Guard in the enlisted
13	grades E-1 through E-6 who have completed their initial six-year term of enlistment."
14	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
