AN ACT TO RAISE THE REIMBURSEMENT TO COUNTIES FOR STATE INMATES HOUSED IN LOCAL CONFINEMENT FACILITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11 12 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of eight million four hundred ninety-one thousand four hundred nineteen dollars (\$8,491,419) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of eight million four hundred ninety-one thousand four hundred nineteen dollars (\$8,491,419) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to raise the per diem reimbursement to counties from fourteen dollars and fifty cents (\$14.50) per day to thirty dollars (\$30.00) per day for State inmates serving sentences of 30 days or more in local confinement facilities.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
