The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 11.3 of S.L. 1997-443 reads as rewritten: "Section 11.3. Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act becomes effective October 1, 1997 and expires on June 30, 1998. October 1, 1997." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
