2	AN ACT PERTAINING TO THE COVERAGE OF POSTMASTECTOMY
3	INPATIENT CARE UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE PLANS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the
6	following new section to read:
7	"§ 58-3-171.1. Coverage for postmastectomy inpatient care.
8	(a) Every entity providing a health benefit plan that provides coverage for
9	mastectomy, including coverage for postmastectomy inpatient care, shall ensure that the
10	decision whether to discharge the patient following mastectomy is made by the attending
11	physician in consultation with the patient, and shall further ensure that the length of
12	postmastectomy hospital stay is based on the unique characteristics of each patient taking
13	into consideration the health and medical history of the patient.
14	(b) As used in this section, 'health benefit plans' means accident and health
15	insurance policies or certificates; nonprofit hospital or medical service corporation
16	contracts; health, hospital, or medical service corporation plan contracts; health
17	maintenance organization (HMO) subscriber contracts; and plans provided by a MEWA
18	or plans provided by other benefit arrangements, to the extent permitted by ERISA."
19	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to health
20	benefit plans issued, renewed, or amended on and after that date.
