Section 1. G.S. 14-415.20 reads as rewritten:

## "§ 14-415.20. No liability of sheriff. sheriff; certain other persons.

- (a) A sheriff who issues or refuses to issue a permit to carry a concealed handgun under this Article shall not incur any civil or criminal liability as the result of the performance of the sheriff's duties under this Article.
- (b) A person who is in legal possession or control of premises shall not incur civil or criminal liability under this Article for either posting or not posting a sign allowing or prohibiting another person to carry a concealed handgun on the premises in accordance with this Article."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
