1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF LENOIR TO ALLOW
3	SALARY INCREASES FOR THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE MAYOR AND TO
4	ALLOW THE MAYOR TO BE ELECTED FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Notwithstanding Section 2.9 of the Charter of the City of Lenoir,
7	being Chapter 118 of the 1977 Session Laws, the city council may increase the salaries of
8	the mayor and the council members by ordinance adopted no less than 30 days after the
9	1997 municipal elections are held. The increase may go into effect immediately. Unless
10	authorized by the General Assembly, any additional increases in the mayor's or council
11	members' salary shall be in accordance with Section 2.9 of the Charter.
12	Section 2. Section 3.2 of the Charter of the City of Lenoir, being Chapter 118
13	of the 1977 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:
14	"Sec. 3.2. Election of the mayor. At the regular municipal election in 1977, 1997,
15	and biennially quadrennially thereafter, there shall be elected a mayor to serve a term of
16	two-four years. The mayor shall be elected by all the voters of the city voting at large."
17	Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
