The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
Section 1. G.S. 20-141 is amended by adding a new subsec	ction to read:
"(e1) Local authorities, in their respective jurisdictions, upon the	request of, and with
the approval of, a local school administrative unit for public school	
body of a private school, may authorize by ordinance lower speeds than those set out in	
subsection (b) of this section, not to exceed 15 miles per hour, on all school property.	
Speed limits set pursuant to this subsection shall be effective when appropriate signs	

giving notice of the speed limits are erected upon the affected property."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
