G.S. 128-21(11b) reads as rewritten: "(11b) 'Law Enforcement Officer' means a full-time paid employee of an employer who is actively serving in a position with assigned primary duties and responsibilities for prevention and detection of crime or for the general enforcement of the criminal laws of the State or for serving civil processes, and who possesses the power of arrest by virtue of an oath administered under the authority of the State. employer, who possesses the power of arrest, who has taken the law enforcement oath administered under the authority of the State as prescribed by G.S. 11-11, and who is certified under the provisions of Chapter 17C or Chapter 17E of the General Statutes." Section 2. G.S. 143-166.50(a)(3) reads as rewritten: 'Law-enforcement officer' means a full-time paid employee of an employer, who is actively serving in a position with assigned primary
