BILL SUMMARY: **S 474. MUNICIPALITIES' TREE ORDINANCES.** *TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWNS OF CORNELIUS, DAVIDSON, AND HUNTERSVILLE TO ADOPT ORDINANCES REGULATING REMOVAL, REPLACEMENT AND PRESERVATION OF TREES WITHIN THE TOWNS.* As title indicates. Municipality's governing board must hold public hearing before adopting ordinance and announce hearing as required in GS 160A-364.¹

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: Page 1, line 8 of the bill contains language that makes these provisions permissive, rather than mandatory. If however, an ordinance is adopted, a public hearing is required, and may involve additional costs. There is no time limitation as to when a municipality may adopt ordinances, so that it would be possible to budget for any anticipated increases in public hearing expenditures, either through a budgeted increase or a reductions in other expenditure line items.
