<b>EFFECTIVE DATE</b> : The act is effective when it becomes law.					

**BILL SUMMARY**: The bill creates a seven member North Carolina Board of Athletic Trainer Examiners to license athletic trainers.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY**: The group advocating this legislation estimates there are 600 athletic trainers in the state that are eligible for licensure. A spokesman for the group also projects that 25 new licenses will be issued each year. The initial license is \$100, the annual renewal is \$50, and reinstatement of a lapsed license is \$75. This fiscal note assumes the licensing of 600 persons in FY 1997-98 and 25 new licenses each year thereafter. License revenue will fund Board expenses and some clerical assistance, but will not be sufficient to hire full time staff.
