10		sine die. All bills shall be excluded from introduction or consideration
11		in the House, other than bills providing for the adoption of a State plan
12		for the purpose of receiving federal money under Title XXI of the
13		Social Security Act for children's health care coverage.
14	(6)	Notwithstanding Rule 31.1, all bills or resolutions must be introduced
15	(0)	not later than 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 25, 1998.
16	(7)	Notwithstanding Rule 41:
17	(,)	a. The first reading and reference to a standing committee of a
18		House bill shall occur on the legislative day of its introduction.
19		The first reading and reference to a standing committee of a
20		Senate bill shall occur on the legislative day of its receipt on
21		messages from the Senate. Provided that, notwithstanding Rule
22		32 and Rule 38, if the Senate bill is identical to a House bill
23		already on the calendar, the Speaker may, after first reading,
