| 9 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 10 | Section 1.(a) The Division of Environmental Health of the Department of |
| 11 | Environment and Natural Resources shall review the current rules adopted pursuant to |
| 12 | Part 6 of Article 8 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes that apply to procedures that |
| 13 | must be followed by lodging establishments concerning coffee pots and ice buckets that |
| 14 | are placed in guest rooms for use by guests of the establishment, shall consult during this |
| 15 | review with representatives of the affected industry and the various agencies responsible |
| 16 | for implementing the applicable rules, and shall recommend rules, revised as needed, to |
| 17 | the Commission for Health Services. |
| 18 | Section l.(b) Current rules that apply to equipment concerning coffee pots and ice |
| 19 | buckets that are placed by lodging establishments in guest rooms for use by guests of the |
| 20 | establishment are suspended until revised rules under this act have been adopted. |

1 Section l.(c) The Commission for Health Services shall adopt the revised rules 2 under subsection (a) of this section as temporary rules no later than January 31, 2000.

3 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
