AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ELECTRONIC COMMERCE DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.

14 15 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Secretary of State, the sum of ninety-eight thousand dollars (\$98,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for the implementation of the Department's Electronic Commerce Demonstration Project. The purpose of the Project shall be the production and delivery of certificates of existence by means of electronic media, including the Internet and World Wide Web. The funds appropriated may be used for design, programming, and other functions necessary for or associated with the electronic production and delivery of certificates of existence by the Department pursuant to the North Carolina Business Corporation Act, Nonprofit Corporation Act, and Limited Liability Company Act.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
