A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THE TEACHER CADET PROGRAM IN HIGH SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to implement, through the North Carolina Foundation for Public School Children, the Teacher Cadet Program in high schools throughout the State. The purpose of the Teacher Cadet Program is to increase the number of students seeking an education degree, increase their SAT scores, enhance networking between teachers, students, and colleges, and help reduce teacher shortages and teacher attrition.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
