A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES FACILITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of fifteen million seven hundred sixty-nine thousand thirty-one dollars (\$15,769,031) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. These funds shall be used as follows:

- (1) \$3,000,000 for State psychiatric hospital physical plant design related to downsizing State psychiatric hospitals.
- (2) \$6,769,031 for capital expenditures for Whitaker School, as follows:
 - a. \$6,181,807 for construction, including site development, administration unit, education unit, four lodges, and maintenance building.
 - b. \$185,454 for contingencies.
 - c. \$401,770 for design fees.

These funds replace funds appropriated for this purpose but used for Hurricane Floyd recovery efforts.

- 1 (3) \$600,000 for Black Mountain Center Neuro-Behavioral Unit for Brain
2 Injury.
3 (4) \$5,400,000 for Cherry Hospital Kids Unit.
4 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
